Bowden Court

Short description of residence:	Bowden Court is a large, budget student residence on a leafy street in the fashionable Notting Hill Gate area of London. It is popular for its international clientele and fantastic location. The rooms are basic but comfortable with a wash basin and good storage space.
Dates available:	All year round (Limited availability in summer months).
Accommodation type:	Half-board, single rooms. Twin rooms are available but limited.
Minimum Age	18 years old.
Minimum/Maximum booking period:	1 week minimum booking.
Deposit	On arrival you will be asked for a £20 deposit for the key and/or pass to your room. This will be returned to you when you return the key at the end of your stay. Please be aware if you lose your key or pass there is a £10 charge per item.
Check in/Check out:	Reception is manned at all times apart from between 04:30am and 06:00am.
Meal times:	Monday to Friday breakfast is served 07:00-08:15 and dinner is served 18:30-20:00. At the weekend breakfast is served later between 09:30-10:30 and lunch is served instead of dinner between 12:30-13:30.
Facilities offered:	This is a basic residence with a small garden for residents to use. There are smoking and non-smoking TV rooms, a lounge, a study room, internet room, laundry room and vending machines. Bed linen is provided at the residence but please note you will need to bring your own towels. Bathrooms (showers and baths) and toilets are shared at a ratio of 1:4. The rooms are cleaned every day apart from weekends.
Internet Access:	There is an internet room available for all residents, for one hour the price is £1. In addition, there is wireless connection; this costs £3 per week.
Security:	Reception is manned at all times apart from between 04:30 and 06:00am. There are also safe boxes available to hire for your valuable goods, these cost £1 per day or £3.50 per week. If students stay for a long period the price of a safe per month is £10.
How to get to Central School of English:	The nearest underground is Notting Hill Gate, just a short walk away. From there students can take the Central (red) line Eastbound 6 stops to Tottenham Court Road. This journey takes approximately 20 minutes. Alternatively, students can take the bus to school. Bus Stop "M" by Notting Hill Gate underground station. Bus 390 towards Archway Station stops directly outside Tottenham Court Station. This journey takes approximately 45 minutes.
Guest Policy:	It is necessary to check with the School or with the Residence whether it is possible for a guest to stay over (price per night will be quoted). Students are not allowed to put guests up without making a relevant booking for them.
Cancellation Policy:	Minimum one week of notice applies.
