Short description of residence:	Dinwiddy House is a university hall of residence built in 1996. It is divided into apartments consisting of between 5-7 bedrooms, and a kitchen. It is well located between Kings Cross and Islington and has a friendly atmosphere and excellent support staff. It offers single en-suite rooms set around a landscaped courtyard which helps to provide a communal spirit.		
Dates available:	Mid June to Mid September. (Summer Only).		
Accommodation type:	Self-Catering single rooms with private bathroom.		
Minimum Age	18 years old.		
Minimum/Maximum booking period:	1 week minimum booking.		
Deposit	No deposit necessary.		
Check in/Check out:	Students can check-in after 14:00. They will then receive a welcome pack, keys and an entry swipe card. Check out must be before 10:00.		
Meal times:	This is a self-catering residence so there are no set meal times.		
Facilities offered:	<p>Rooms are arranged in flats of five, six, or seven bedrooms. Each flat is self-contained with a shared kitchen and dining area comprising of two cookers, two fridges, two sinks, a microwave and a freezer.</p> <p>Storage space is provided in the kitchen and each resident has their own lockable food storage cupboard. The kitchen and communal corridor are cleaned on a weekly basis. A vacuum cleaner is provided so residents can clean their own rooms. Students are responsible for keeping the communal areas clean and tidy and for doing their own washing up. The rooms are study bedrooms, each with its own en-suite shower, toilet and basin. A bed, desk, chair, bookcase, wardrobe and drawers are provided and there are electrical sockets for residents to use their own computer, radio etc. There is also a telephone and an internet point for a broadband internet service. Bed linen is provided but students must bring a towel.</p> <p>All residents have access to a common room with TV, DVD, pool table and vending machines. There is also a coin operated launderette on site.</p>		
Internet Access:	On arrival students receive a welcome pack, which includes details of the internet access offered. There is a monthly rate for this service which depends on upon the speed of the connection selected.		
Security:	Reception manned 24 hours a day. There are security boxes in all the rooms - £1.50 per day.		
How to get to Central School of English:	From Kings Cross Station, students can take the Piccadilly (dark blue) line on the underground to Holborn and from there it is a 5-10 minute walk to the school. There is also a bus stop outside Dinwiddy House and bus 73 will bring students directly to Tottenham Court Road. The bus takes approximately 20 minutes. It is also possible to walk to school from Dinwiddy House. This will take approximately 30 minutes.		
Guest Policy:	Please check with the school. Students are not allowed to have guests to stay without making a booking for them in advance.		
Cancellation Policy:	Minimum of two weeks' notice.
