## Hughes Parry Hall

<b>Short description of residence:</b>	<p>Hughes Parry Hall is one of eight University of London intercollegiate halls and provides accommodation for 300 male and female students.</p> <p>It was opened in 1969 and provides accommodation on 14 floors. It is located in the Central University precinct and is ideally located for London's West End theatres, cinemas and shopping attractions.</p> <p>The Hall has excellent public transport links with King's Cross and Euston mainline and underground stations and Russell Square, Goodge Street and Euston Square underground stations are all close by. The Hall is situated near all the major bus routes passing through and around central London.</p>
<b>Dates available:</b>	July and August (Summer only).
<b>Accommodation type:</b>	Half Board or Bed and Breakfast. Single rooms.
<b>Minimum Age</b>	18 years old.
<b>Minimum/Maximum booking period:</b>	1 week minimum booking period.
<b>Deposit</b>	No deposit necessary.
<b>Check in/Check out:</b>	<p>Check in: After 12pm</p> <p>Check out: Keys to rooms are issued on arrival and must be handed to the Reception Desk before 10.00am on the day of departure.</p>
<b>Meal times:</b>	<p>Breakfast: from Monday to Friday: 8.00 to 9.00</p> <p>Saturday and Sunday 8.30 to 9.30</p> <p>Dinner: 18.00 to 19.00</p>
<b>Facilities offered:</b>	<p>There is a bar, a television lounge with flat-screen TV and games rooms with table-tennis table. Additionally, arrangements can be made for both squash and tennis.</p> <p>Rooms are serviced weekly. Bed linen and hand towels are provided. Students should bring their own bath towels. Coin operated washing machines and a dryer is available together with ironing facilities. Coin operated telephones are situated throughout the building. There are facilities for making hot drinks on each floor.</p>
<b>Internet Access:</b>	All rooms have internet access.
<b>Security:</b>	For security reasons the front doors are locked at midnight. The Night Porter can be called by using the door bell.
<b>How to get to Central School of English:</b>	It takes 20 to 25 minutes to walk to school from the residence. Alternatively, students can take the underground-Northern Line (black line) from Euston Station directly to Tottenham Court Road. This journey will take 15 minutes.
<b>Guest Policy:</b>	Please check with the school. Students are not allowed to have guests to stay without making a booking for them in advance.
<b>Cancellation Policy:</b>	Minimum of two weeks' notice applies.
