International Students House

Short description of residence:	International Students House (ISH) is a big student residence located in the heart of London, next to Regent's Park. It is very popular due to its truly multi-cultural character, lively atmosphere, attractive location and good facilities. ISH comprises two neighbouring buildings which are located approximately 7 minutes walk from each other. ISH offers single and twin rooms on either a half board or bed and breakfast basis.
Dates available:	All year round.
Accommodation type:	HB and BB
Minimum Age	18 years old.
Minimum/Maximum booking period:	1 week minimum booking.
Deposit	Students receive a "Smart Card" which allows access to the building, bedroom and allows to obtain a meal at the restaurant. There is a £10 refundable deposit for the "Smart Card". In case the card is lost students have to pay £15 charge.
Check in/Check out:	Students should check in at the main building - 229 Great Portland Street Check in - anytime after 12:30 PM Check out - before 10:00 AM
Meal times:	Meals are taken at the main building - Great Portland Street. Breakfast: 07:30 - 10:00 Monday to Friday 08:00 - 10:00 at weekends Dinner: 17:30 - 19:30 Monday to Friday 18:00 - 19:30 at weekends
Facilities offered:	A wide range of facilities are offered and these include a restaurant / canteen where meals are taken, a lounge bar, an internet café, a newly equipped gym (extra cost for using a gym: single entry £5, monthly membership £25 or an 6 months/annual membership £150), a laundrette (coin operated) and vending machines (coin operated). Bed linen and hand towels are provided.
Internet Access:	There is an internet café + wireless internet connection (available in: Cybercafe, Restaurant, Reception, and Bar area). Broadband internet access is also offered in rooms (extra cost for broadband: £12.00 per month or less. The price for 3 months connection is £30.00).
Security:	Reception is manned 24 hours per day.
How to get to Central School of English:	The nearest underground station is Great Portland Street (Hammersmith & City, Metropolitan and Circle Lines). You can also walk to the residence from school and it takes approximately 20 minutes. When you leave the school, turn left and keep walking. Pass Goodge Street underground station and walk straight on until you get to Euston Road (next to Warren Street station). Turn left into Euston Road and keep walking until you see another underground station which is Great Portland Street. The residence is just behind the station.
Guest Policy:	It is necessary to check with the School or with the Residence whether it is possible for a guest to stay over (price per night will be quoted). Students are not allowed to put guests up without making a relevant booking for them.
Cancellation Policy:	Minimum one week of notice applies.
